Where a tug is called out to standby a vessel 50% of the scheduled charges will apply.

A fuel charge of \$139.01 applies per tug engaged for the period 1 July 2025 to 30 September 2025, effective 1 July 2025. This charge is reviewed quarterly and updated accordingly based on the "Terminal Gate Price for diesel".

# CANCELLATIONS

# **SHIFTS**

All vessel shifts within the harbour (other than a shift for log fumigation\*) will be charged at 50% of the applicable service charges (i.e. pilotage, towage and mooring).

\* If a vessel is shifted to a berth for fumigation of logs, then an all-up charge of \$5,835.00 per move will apply.

## **OTHER VESSELS**

#### CHARGE

Charges for vessels without propulsion or of special characteristics (e.g. offshore rigs, barges, etc.) will be determined by the port based on the complexity of the operation and resources engaged.
